

## 1. Female Students' Hair:

Proper hair styles(s)

No weaves or wigs

No dyes, no streaks, no highlights, no lowlights

No beads or hair adornments

No Faux locks, no two-strand twists, no crochet braids, no goddess braids, no Marley braids, no faddish braids

Braids with extensions are privilege and not a right. Only 3-strand braids are permitted and must be worn at shoulder length

#### 2. Male Students' Hair:

Hair must be kept short and neatly trimmed

Hair must not cover eyebrows, necks and foreheads

#### 3. TARDINESS

Attendance is taken at 8:20 a.m. during the morning homeroom session. Any scholar not present in the homeroom at this time is considered late.
